


Pages 12-16 show exploded view of trailers and extension frames with list of parts.

These simple instructions show you in easy stages all you need to know on how to assemble your Conway Trailer Tent. Every model shares the same basic assembly system but there are variations in the final stages for each model. When you have completed all the stages shown here, just unfold the relevant pages for your model to finish off.


A Conway Trailer Tent will take you only minutes to erect, and needs the minimum of effort — it really is child's play.




**1.** Unhitch trailer from car. Position on as level ground as possible. Drop down the four trailer corner jacks.




**3.** Drop the four corner kitchen support jacks to within ½ inch of ground. Release the two protex fasteners on either side of the kitchen, which will in turn release the kitchen from trailer.



**4.** Now slide kitchen away enough to disconnect 7 pin plug.



5. Slide the kitchen off carrying rails and away from the trailer




2. Remove cover by detaching elastic cord from black plastic cleats.




**6.** Swing over left hand cabin roof support frames and then same on right hand side.

7. Lift up the two hinged arms to form the 5th roof support pole.



11. Clip the inner tents to the framework.



**8.** Extend each of the 4 cabin support poles by pushing upwards simultaneously at front and back. Locate the small button clip in the centre at the back of 5 holes in each pole. Adjust as necessary when pegging out.



12. Pull down all walls of cabin canvas.



**9.** Fold over each bed board and mattress to each side. Check that each bed leg is securely located and adjust as necessary.




10. Release elastic bands restraining inner tents and mattresses.

### **CONWAY CORNICHE**


The flagship of the Conway range, the Corniche is practical as well as supremely comfortable. Its zip-on extension allows overnight stopping with the minimum of effort, and on site its abundance of superb features make it the last word in camping luxury.



**14.** Layout framework for short 1-4m extension. See parts list overleaf for detailed diagram.




**17.** Pull forward extension canvas from main tent and locate short canopy poles through gussets.



**18.** If the tent is to be used in the Weekender position, the loose wall should now be zipped in and the tent pegged out with all zips closed.




**15.** Connect centre extension roof pole to main cabin by means of hook and attach to centre extension 'A' frame.




**19.** Zip main extension canvas to short Weekender extension.



16. Add side cabin roof poles and legs.



**20.** Throw canvas back over main tent.




**21.** Layout main extension frame. See parts list overleaf for detailed diagram.




**24.** Pull extension canvas forward over extension frame.




\*22. (i) Slide extension roof poles over short canopy poles of Weekender extension.
(ii) Connect centre roof pole to main extension 'A' frame.




**25.** Locate three short canopy poles.



23. Connect legs and side roof poles to main extension 'A' frame.





**26.** Adjust frame as necessary and peg out with all zips closed. The removable panel should be zipped into main extension when pegging out.




