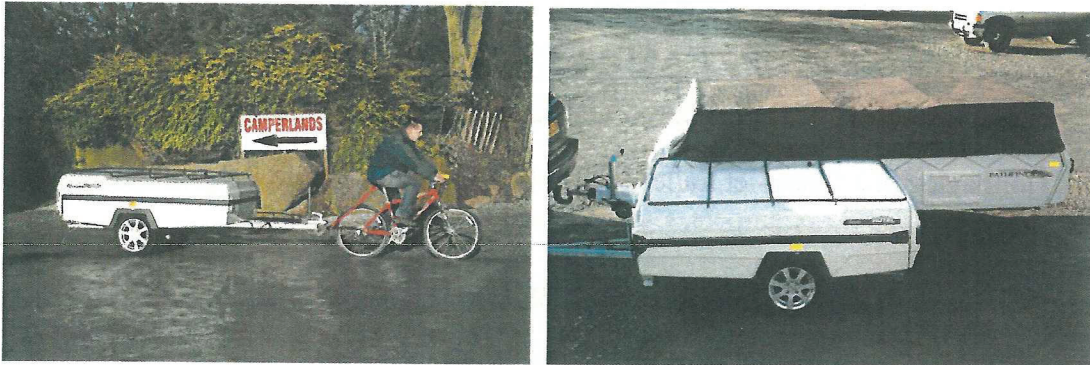

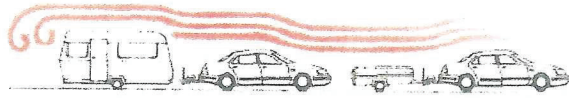

## BY APPOINTMENT

Camperlands are still proud to be appointed the sole importer and distributor for this unique product. The Camp-Let joins the growing list of trailer tent and camper brands on offer at Camperlands, many of which are totally unique to anything else on offer to the U.K. trailer tent market today. The word unique can sometimes imply the existence of a degree of impracticality or a lack of universal appeal. This is certainly not true of the latest Danish offering from **Camp-Let**.

This unique design is a clear winner. Many ex-caravan, motorhome and folding camper users are switching over to this compact and lightweight camper due to its ease of use, design and overall quality. The importers, Camperlands are retailers for 5 manufacturers. Since the arrival of the Camp-Let in January 2006 it has seriously affected the sales of the competition, with customers being prepared to pay that little bit extra to buy the best.

Camp-Let production started in 1969 in a small town call Arnum in southern Denmark. Like many successful businesses the Camp-Let was, and still is, a family owned concern. Hans Nissen the Director of the company has informed us that the name **Camp-Let translates into "quick set up - quality and design"**.

## COMBINED TRAILER TENT AND FOLDING CAMPER

The Camp-Let combines the best features of both folding camper and trailer tent. The cabin section is non pegging with a kitchen permanently attached to the trailer (no heavy lifting), therefore it is a folding camper! The trailer size is small and compact and is not to be confused or compared to the much heavier and larger trailers used by folding campers. A small compact trailer is a big advantage over folding camper trailers, for towing, storing and general handling. The Camp-Let can be stored on its side with the use of mobile side stores. Once the Camp-Let is on its side it could be wheeled into the corner of a garage. The Camp-Let has running water all but one model and can also be equipped with fridge, mains electrics and a full 12v system with leisure battery. The Camp-Let can give you all the luxuries of a folding camper but has the advantage of a compact trailer, it is proving to be a real winner!

## IT'S OFFICIAL

For the last 8 years the Camp-Let has been voted "BEST LIGHTWEIGHT TRAILER TENT" at the Birmingham National Exhibition Centre. The competition was run and judged by the Caravan Club. Judges were looking for overall design strengths, ease of use including, set-up and packing away, features, product guarantee, quality and value for money. The Camp-Let came up against the main U.K. and European manufacturers.

## QUALITY FROM THE ROAD UP

To see the Camp-Let in the flesh, is to appreciate its quality, which becomes immediately apparent the moment you set eyes on it. The robust body shell is manufactured from reinforced fibreglass, which gives the Camp-Let the deceptive appearance of being much heavier than it actually is; in fact the Camp-Let's starting weight is just 225kg, incredibly light for any trailer tent. Driving with the Camp-Let is such a pleasure, its excellent driving characteristics, unobstructed rear view, good fuel economy and classic design has made the Camp-Let a popular travel companion throughout the U.K. and Europe.

## HARD TOP

The traditional style Camp-Lets came as standard with a hard top and luggage rack whilst the latest 5<sup>th</sup> Generation models gives a deeper lid for more internal storage with channels to fit optional extras such as a luggage rack, bike carriers etc. The lockable hard top is a big advantage over the rivals as it provides a safe and secure trailer with the ability to store additional equipment on top. It is no problem to carry bikes - top box - cases - windsurfer or fishing gear etc.

# Designed for speed

Arguably the best trailer tents around

**BEFORE WE** look at the Savanne in detail let's consider its killer feature. Here is a family trailer tent that one person can pitch inside ten minutes – and erect to protect everything from the elements within two. It was this speed that converted me to trailer tents. Not just any trailer tent – it has to be a Camp-let. Do not believe me? Let's break down the pitching process.

1. Let down the corner steadies – an easy process if you use a socket on the end of a power drill.
2. Place the floor supports into the trailer's roof bars
3. Unlock and swing out the kitchen unit – drop its legs to take the weight
4. Swing over the trailer roof so it becomes the floor of one of the two bedroom compartments – a gas strut makes this is easy
5. Pull out the frame support on the kitchen side of the camper's body
6. Unzip the front canvas panel at its apex and use the short key pole to join the main poles
7. Pull up the canvas to create cabin and awning living space
8. Pull out the telescopic main poles to create shape and height
9. Peg out the corners
10. Brew up and relax

At this stage the unit can be used in mild conditions but more pegs and guys can be set if the weather looks like it might turn or you are on site for longer. If you still need convincing then check out the video on the website [camperlands.co.uk](http://camperlands.co.uk) – the Danish company's UK importer.

If this is not enough we also have a superbly designed unit that has hardly changed in 30-something years. The fibreglass is hand laid, the fittings are

stainless steel and the Ten Cate cotton is supplied from neighbouring Isabella – it has to be amongst the finest fabric around. No wonder these units last a camper's lifetime.

The Savanne is based on the popular Concorde, but differs in one intriguing way. The whole of the front panel and half of the sidewalls at a diagonal can be removed to create a huge sun porch. Initially, the only advantage over the traditional design that I could see was if the unit was being used on hot Continental shores. But it turns out that the Savanne is the popular choice with anglers who can fish undercover from the big awning and have all the luxuries to hand when fishing overnight. The pitching speed, massive sun porch and quick-to-use kitchen also makes the Savanne ideal for days out – just picture it down at the beach or as a base for watersports...

As mentioned, the kitchen

can be swung out and used for a roadside picnic when en route to your campsite. It features plenty of storage space, a gas hob and a 12V pumped cold water system that includes a tap.

On site storage includes a wardrobe situated between the two bedroom compartments and pelmet pockets. The skirt that cuts down the draft from under the trailer body has large integrated underbed zip-close storage bins.

Wooden lath sprung beds can be specified for comfort – as can full mat insulation of the cabin floor.

**Camping says** If you are looking for a large quality tent

of any description, consider Camp-let – you cannot fault its quality or the competitive price.

It is worth a day trip to Camperlands in south Manchester – here you can find upwards of 60 tents pitched along with Camp-let and competing units. No need for hard sell – you can see the difference for yourself.

Camperlands also offers a number of special package deals throughout the year. And, of course, you can discuss tailoring your unit by adding optional extras that include gas locker, jockey wheel, bike rack, sun canopy side and front screens, and a guest cabin. **CG**

## Cotton Canvas v Acrylic Your Decision

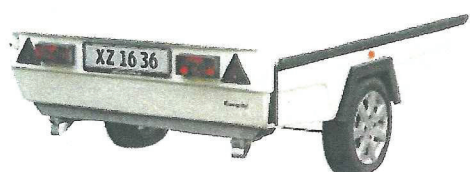
There is much discussion and debate at the present time regarding the various benefits and drawbacks of the traditional cotton canvas and the newer acrylic fabrics when used as the covering for a trailer tent or folding camper. Given Camperland's long experience of over 40 years in the camping business, we thought it might be helpful to provide our view on the relative merits of the two fabrics.

	<u>Cotton Canvas</u>	<u>Acrylic Fabric</u>
Experience of use	Good quality cotton canvas has been used very successfully ever since camping began ! Experience has shown how best to use it and look after it ( over 50 years )	Acrylic fabric has also been around for quite a while. Modern fabrics are now very good and compare favourably with cotton canvas specially the Isabella version used on the Camp-let range
Durability	Up to 25 – 30 years in normal use (Depending on Quality)	Top quality acrylic can last 25 – 30 years
Water Resistant	100% Up to a certain head of pressure	100% Up to a certain head of pressure
Folded Away whilst wet	Can be folded away. But needs drying.	Can be folded away. But needs drying.
Water Absorbance	Level of water absorbance depends on grade of canvas	Level of water absorbance depends on grade of acrylic, but will dry quicker
Resistant to fading	Good if looked after	Good if Highest quality fabric is used
Resistant to mildew	Good.	Very Good but mildew can still form if not dried out
Breathability / comfort	Breathable. Provides more comfort in hot conditions and less condensation	Breathable unless Plastic coated.
Cleaning	Easily brushed off. Stubborn stains removed with water	Similar but easier to clean.
Proofing	Recommended re-proofed every 8 - 10 years, however regular proofing will extend life of canvas	Plastic coated Acrylic needs NO proofing. Standard acrylic treated like Canvas
Cost	High Quality Canvas - Expensive	Currently more expensive
Quality Matters	Be aware that there are several different grades of Canvas and Acrylic in the marketplace. The performance of them is NOT all the same	
Other	Camp-let are now using the highest grade of cotton and acrylic on their trailer tent range	

The key thing is the quality of the materials used and the way they are looked after. It is generally believed in the scientific community that high quality cotton treated well would last longer than high quality acrylic treated well, but that if they were treated badly (i.e. left in the sun for months, put away wet, etc.) the acrylic would last longer.
