

The Pennine Alpine trailer tent has been expertly designed to combine the advantages of a caravan with the freedom and economy of life under canvas. It offers the added advantages of easy towing and storage, clear rear viewing, and economy of motor fuel compared with caravan towing.

The Alpine can be erected in under three minutes (on concrete if need be) with no pegging out of canvas whatsoever, and giving ample off the ground sleeping for six people.

The Pennine Alpine provides the standard of luxury family accommodation, hitherto only available in a caravan in a compact easy to tow trailer. The seating and sleeping arrangements have been designed to give the maximum of comfort whether dining or lounging and the whole of the interior has been carefully co-ordinated to give an extremely pleasing caravan style appearance.



The Tent & Interior


When erected, the Alpine Trailer Tent has a spacious and comfortable interior. The two bed extensions provide separate curtained off bedrooms complete with inner tents which can remain made up throughout the holiday, and the sleeping bags remain in position even in transit. This eliminates the daily task of making up the beds as is necessary in most caravans – definitely a favourite with the ladies. For your comfort, the mattresses are of 3" thick foam complete with strong removable mattress covers and the seats are 4" thick foam button upholstered in Dralon fabric. The seats, seat backs and the large, attractive table fold down to form a third double bed

across the trailer whilst still leaving adequate space to move about and use the sink and cooker units.


The kitchen unit is elevated to a conventional working height and comprises of a polished stainless steel combination sink unit with drainer and a double burner cooker unit with simmer taps and a grill complete with grill pan. A fold-away faucet, water pump and cutlery drawer are also included as standard equipment. The kitchen unit top is split, which together with the ancillary serving shelf, allows plenty of working surface for the preparation of meals. All working surfaces are clad with durable easy clean Decamel decorative laminate. All these standard facilities combine to give the Alpine a most




A new standard feature is a cutlery drawer.

comprehensive and useful kitchen unit.

There is plenty of storage space, too $-48\,\mathrm{cu}$. ft. altogether, comprising of double fronted cupboard in the kitchen unit and underseat storage. In addition, a utility locker is provided for those items which are frequently used.

The luxuriously appointed interior of the trailer has a fitted carpet between the seats and a practical, easy clean vinyl floor covering in the kitchen area. Attractively patterned curtains and roof lining complete a carefully co-ordinated and most pleasing interior decor.

The canvas is manufactured entirely from highest

quality roofing weight proofed cotton, ensuring the very best protection in all weather conditions. The canvas is attached to the trailer with press studs and Velcro to give a secure draught-proof fitting. In addition, the lower walls of the canvas have a vinyl sheeting liner sewn in to give extra protections in heavy weather conditions.





Optional extras

1. Skirt for bed extension . . .

Skirts may be fitted round the underside of the beds, providing useful storage when on site.

2. Chest Refrigerator . . .

·81 cu. ft. Triple Operation (Mains/12v/Gas). An extremely useful item which is particularly handy when touring in warmer climates.

3. Catalytic Heater (1·38kW/4,750 Btu)

A very useful addition which enables you to camp in comfort whatever the climate.

4. Awning (16ft. × 6ft. 6in.)

The simple erected detachable awning doubles the living area of the unit.






