

EMPTYING

It is advisable to empty the waste tank earlier. The waste level indicator latest, when the waste level indicator has turned from green to fully red does not begin to change from green to red until the tank is 3/4 full. The waste tank has a capacity of 20 litres. This must be emptied, at the

Note! Do not allow the waste tank to become too full.

Note! Never use Vaseline or any vegetable oil except olive oil These may cause leakage

If the toilet will not be used for a long period, it is advisable to clean the seals and coat them lightly with olive oil. This will ensure that they remain in good condition (supple).

Depending on the extent and manner of service, after a certain period the seal will lose quality and must be replaced. N.B. The valve blade seal is a part of the toilet that is subject to wear
